Preventative healthcare plan.
Protection from pain, suffering, injury and disease

Feeding.

Dogs that do not have written consent to be fed with other dogs will be separated prior to any food preparation starting. Once food has been prepared these dogs are fed first so that I am free to watch the remaining dogs eat. All dogs that are fed together will be spaced out and supervised until the last dog has finished. All bowls will be removed after feeding.

Owners to provide their dogs food. Owners will advise the quantity of food provided.

Feeding will always take place no less than one hour prior or one hour after exercise.

All food bowls will be washed after each meal and disinfected between dogs or weekly whichever is sooner.

Cleaning.

All dog rooms will be cleaned daily. Water bowls cleaned and refilled daily or more frequent if necessary. Dogs will be removed from the room while cleaning.

Faeces will be double bagged and removed from the garden immediately and disposed of in local council poo bins. The patio disinfected as required. Grass to be kept short for ease of faeces removal. The Garden will be checked regularly for any damage or wear that may cause injury to the dogs.

Transportation.

Dogs will be transported in the boot of the car behind dog guard and tethered or in the crate which is tethered. 2 additional dogs can be harnessed to seat belts on the back seat. The harnesses/crate/dog guard will be cleaned and checked regularly. The car is covered by business insurance. When travelling in hot weather or for prolonged periods water will be provided.

The prevention of, and control of the spread of, disease.

All dogs must be up to date with vaccinations against parvovirus, distemper, hepatitis and leptospirosis. Primary vaccination must be completed at least two weeks prior to stay. All dogs must be up to date with the treatment of internal and external parasites in accordance with veterinary advice prior to boarding. No dogs will be boarded if they have had (within 21 days prior) or currently have an infectious disease prior to boarding.

Consultation with owner's specified vet or another vet will be actioned immediately if any dog is in need of isolation due to suspected symptoms. If required the dog must be taken to the vets and remain there until they are collected by the owner or they are no longer in need of isolation.

Cleaning procedures will be followed.

All faeces and soiled bedding will be double bagged and disposed of in landfill waste.

Monitoring and ensuring the health and welfare of all animals.

All dogs will be checked daily or more regularly if necessary for any signs of pain, suffering, injury, disease or abnormal behaviour. Any abnormal signs of the above need to be recorded in the 'day diary'. Any abnormal presence or absence of faeces and urine will also be recorded.

The death or escape of a dog.

If a dog should pass away during its stay the emergency contact will be notified. The body will be stored at the vets until the owner can collect or gives instruction of its disposal.

When dogs are away from premises they will wear a collar with Pardys Paws contact details. If a dog should escape on a walk or from my premises then every effort will be made to locate and recapture the dog. Local vets, council and police will be made aware. The owner (emergency contact if owner not available) will also be made informed.
