

Pardys Paws

Risk Assessment (Including Fire)

All areas must be kept hazard free at all times

1. Dogs will be kept in designated areas at night.
2. All doors will be closed at night and outside doors locked at all times. A key safe is located outside the front side door – code is held by emergency key holders. Spare keys to outside doors are kept upstairs in bedside cabinet in master bedroom and with emergency key holders.
3. In case of an emergency current boarders full details are on the pin board in the porch.

In case of an emergency where dogs cannot be boarded due to an emergency the two key holders will provide assistance in terms of providing cover during an emergency and alternative accommodation if necessary. Where possible, owners or the nominated emergency contact will be contacted to establish an alternative person the dog could be transferred to.

In the event of death, the owner will be contacted and the dog will be taken to its registered or local veterinary practice. If this is not immediately possible, the dog will be stored in a locked outbuilding until the next day.

6. Fire blanket and fire extinguisher are kept in the kitchen at the end of sink unit.
7. Smoke alarms in lounge and upstairs landing and tested regularly.
8. In case of fire, the nearest/safest exit should be used and outside doors opened to release dogs. Boarding dogs will be accommodated with Mandy and John until owners return. Owners will be notified.
9. Fire guard to always be used when open fire is lit and dogs will not be left unattended in the lounge.
10. Dogs will not be left unattended in the garden.
