Procedures for dogs under one year

1. Full written details will be taken from owners as to what training instructions are being used with their puppy. Training will continue while being boarded at Pardys Paws and logged on the Daily Activity Record. This record is always available to clients. Training a puppy must always be consistent to avoid confusion. Reward-based training (positive training) is given.
2. Puppies will be handle, stroked and groomed every day with constant praise so it becomes used to being handled and learns to trust.
3. Puppies will be exercised based on age appropriate, i.e. 5 min twice per day for each month of life. Additional playful enrichment will be on-going during the day.
4. All puppies will be socialised to allow them to learn how to interact safely with other dogs, both in the house and whilst out walking.
5. Dogs less than one year may still be learning how to interact with people i.e. may still be jumping up and mouthing. This will be monitored carefully when visitors come to the house and when in public. Details of current correction instructions will be obtained in writing from owners.
6. Dogs will be monitored for reactions to new noises and objects that they may not have encountered before and will be aided in a positive manor with new things.
7. Continued support will be available even when your dog is back at home with you.
